NOTES FOR BOURNEMOUTH AND THE CHINES, FEB.17TH 2025

Venue

- The Harvester pub in Durley Chine is the venue (you can park for free in West Overcliff Drive on top of the cliff then walk down - or pay in the Chine car park). You may even spot a control if you do the former! It was not possible to reserve seats but the bar area (on the left as you enter) should not be too busy. But please be courteous to any members of the public who may have gone there for a quiet drink!
- At 7pm, seating for 12 people in the restaurant area, near the bar seating, has been reserved, but you can also eat in the bar area.

Event

- The sides of the Chines must only be ascended/descended via the paths/steps. The Chines are mapped as White with an overlay of the OOB symbol. See blank map available in the pub.
- Some of the paths in the Alum Chine tropical Gardens have been blocked off and these are marked on the map. There is only one path that is usable from bottom to top.
- Small kites are used, even in the park areas.
- Loose control descriptions are provided.
- There are 25 controls, with points varying from 10-50. Total 500.
- Points values are overprinted on the map, with the control codes in brackets afterwards.
- There are some controls in the Upper and Lower Gardens so you may well meet other users. Please be respectful to them.
- Optimum route is about 11-12k, I THINK! Someone may well prove me wrong!
- STARTS will be from the corner diagonally opposite from the pub.
- Clear and Check will be there.
